Posters should be original, colorful, and thought-provoking, and we encourage students to use their imagination to express their ideas. This also makes a great project for classes on Earth Day, April 22nd.

Students and finalists are invited to the judging at the Capitol on May 28th between 12–2:30pm. Semi-Finalists will be displayed at the state Capitol and the 1st, 2nd and 3rd place posters will receive a scholarship this year.

Beginning in July 2022, Connecticut became one of the first states to mandate CLIMATE CHANGE STUDIES (Grades 5–12) as part of its science curriculum in public schools.



In recognition of prioritizing climate education, the CT Coalition for Climate Action will host the second annual 2025 Climate Poster Competition.



Submissions will be accepted through May 1, 2025. Posters will be judged by a committee of environmental leaders, legislators and others. 12 posters will be selected that will be distributed to legislators and available for download to highlight climate issues being studied throughout the state. New this yearthe 1st, 2nd and 3rd place posters will receive a scholarship!

As part of this project, participants will:

- Learn to summarize information and present it visually on a poster
- Highlight an environmental topic of interest
