- Improve energy efficiency and weatherization programs to combat barriers to access
- Expand efficiency and electrification, including cooling and water heater systems, through promotion, incentives and 0% financing

Sustainable Energy Policies and Infrastructure



- Address existing grid constraints through transmission updates, buildout, distributed energy and grid enhancing technologies
- Expand solar deployment to renters and multi-unit households, increase solar installation on car ports and parking lots and lift the cap
- Support networked geothermal
- Ensure continued resiliency funding in the Public Benefits Charge

Foster Resilient Communities

 Support environmental, structural and population resilience assessments in Plans of Conservation and Development and Hazard Mitigation Plans



- Update building and fire codes to ensure resilient and safe infrastructure for our future
- Expand access to heat pumps and solar canopies for vulnerable populations (e.g., assisted living/55+, childcare, schools)

Protect Ratepayers, Enforce Accountability

- Protect ratepayers from paying methane gas subsidies
- Hold climate polluters accountable for climate impacts
